ave we seen the peak in bass boat prices? For several years it seemedlike the prices would never stop rising. 2024 could be the year where they stop as manufacturers caught up with demand last year and inventories are much better. Inflation is ebbing slowly as well. Will manufacturers lower prices? There are some interest rate deals (mostly on Bass Pro Shops brand boats) and special offers that do lower your overall cost to purchase out there, but bass boats have become expense just like everything else that burns gas and moves.

It appears the 21' bass boat craze is slowing a bit with many manufacturers focusing their 2024 efforts on 20' models with 250 hp outboards that permit a slightly lower price point. Keep that in mind as you shop around.

Another bass boat trend we are seeing across the top brands include the incorporation of a shelf in the driver's console where two large screen electronics can be mounted.

Here's what you can expect to see at the winter boat shows and at area dealers' showrooms this spring

Bass Cat

With 10 models to choose from all manufactured in Mountain Home, Arkansas, Bass Cat has always set itself apart from other boat builders. New for 2024 is the Caracal STS a boat that positions itself in the high end 20' bass boat segment at 20'2" long, 96" wide, weighing 1,890 pounds, with a 52-gallon fuel capacity (twin tanks) and 300 max hp rating. The boat comes with plenty of standard features including Humminbird electronics and a Minn Kota Ulterra trolling motor, 28-ounce carpet, 4 gauge trolling motor wiring, Hydro Turf on the cockpit floor, triangular livewell openings, understeat storage, coinbox step up to back deck and step up to front deck cooler, a unique front deck center storage compartment, adjustable trollilng motor foot pedal placement and room for two fishfinders on the bow, plus six stainless steel cupholders throughout the boat.

Caymas

Earl Bentz is back in the boat building business with Caymas. The company was founded in 2018 and the boats are built in their own Ashland City, Tennessee plant. Bentz was a pioneer boat racer/boat builder that created bass boat companies like HydraSports, Stratos, Javelin and Triton and he's taken all he's learned over his many years in the industry and produced the Caymas fresh and saltwater hulls.

THE CX 20 is the fastest model in Caymas' line of premium tournament bass boats. The CX 20 hull is 20' 4" in length and sports a 96" beam. Most anglers are powering the CX 20 with a 250hp outboard and enjoying speeds over 75 mph. Order the Caymas CX 20 Pro and the boat will arrive at the dealer with a Lowrance® HDS 9 LIVE at the bow, a Lowrance® HDS 9 LIVE at the console, Lowrance® 2-IN-1 Active Imaging, Lowrance Point-1 antenna, the NEMA harness, Ethernet cable, Oxygen Innovations livewell system, Keel protector, a custom boat cover and a dual disc brake upgrade on trailer. All Caymas CX 20 models are equipped with industry-first Hi-Speed pickup aerator pumps. This pump continues to add freshwater into your livewells while you are running down the lake.

Caymas also offers 18, 19 and 21-foot CX bass boat models.

Falcon

Down in Newberry, South Carolina there is a relatively new bass boat builder that regional anglers have taken a shine to. Falcon offers

hulls of 21, 20, 19 and 18, the most popular of which is the F20 Predator. At 20'2" long, 99" wide with a hull weight of 1,890 pounds, 50-gallon fuel tank and 250 maximum hp rating this boat hauls bass. This boat has rocker-style switches throughout, a sliding tackle tray in the fiberglass center bow storage compartment, a step cooler to the front deck, a dry box that holds two, Plano 3600 boxes in front of the passenger seat, 6 mm foam decking in the cockpit, storage compartment, step up to back deck between driver and passenger seats and chrome trailer fenders. A number of additional standard features including, LED courtesy lights, LED compartment lights, LED livewell light, LED lights on front deck, custom cover, Minn Kota Ultrex 112 iPilot Link with MDI and Humminbird Solix 10 and 12 units make the F20 Predator a great tournament boat.

iKon

This is a new player in the high-end bass boat market (debuted in 2023) designed with pro angler Jacob Wheeler and Brent Butler. The hull design is said to be rooted in the old Hydrasports heritage, if you can remember that far back!

Currently there are LX20 and LX21 models and a VLX model said to be coming this spring. The closest dealer in in South Carolina.

The LX20 is 20'10" long, 98" wide, has a 50-gallon fuel tank and will accommodate up to 250 hp. The boat does have some interesting aspects including a hull that flairs out at the cockpit from the stern – they callit the Hydrodynamic Stabalizer System. Icon did this to incorporate saltwater boat strategies for stability, comfort and speed. Twin rear deck L2 Latonia livewells are gelcoated in light blue with insulated cooler-like lids. This innovative, first-in-class, automated livewell system controls auto-fill, auto-maintain-fill, auto-circulate, auto-oxygenation, auto-inject fish additive, and even auto-temp. The lid and cavity shape designs, united with the integration controls mechanisms and a left-fit chiller plate, produce a healthy environment with antisloshing for fish to survive with only care at the click of helm controls. You can also fill your livewall bag with something called a quick connect fill system. The boat also features a cavernous front deck center tackle storage compartment (said to hold up to 50 tackle boxes) and twin rod lockers (said to be able to handle 36 rods), step up to front deck Yeti-like insulated cooler, coinbox step up to back deck storage, suspended buck seats, twin rear storage compartments (all storage compartments are considered "ultra-dry" with tall gutter system) and gull wing doors to access the battery compartment. The console has a touch screen for many functions including the livewell system.

The Icon LX20 is just over \$100K. The LX21 is over \$120K.

Lund

This Minnesota-based boat manufacturer has perhaps more models than any other boat builder in the world. There are boat options for bass, crappie, muskie, walleye, bay, great lakes, utility and hunting.

The most intriguing options for area anglers are the Pro-V Bass XS, the Renegade and Predator lines.

The Pro-V Bass XS is available in 18 and 20 models. The 1875 XS was made popular by Jon B of the Googan Squad, who used it during the filming of many of his popular YouTube shows. The 1875 XS is 18'9" long, 96" wide, holds 39 gallons of fuel and will handle up to 200 hp. The 2075 XS 20'10" long, 96" wide, holds 49 gallons of fuel and up to 250 hp.

The Renegade Lund line is positioned to compete against Tracker with 17, 18 and 19' models. The 1975 is 19'9" long, 95" wide, holds 32 gallons offuel, weighs 1,520 pounds and takes up to 150 hp on a modified v hull. The back deck has unique, dual pop-up seats set just outside the passenger and driver seats that also serve as lids to rear storage compartments. The cockpit floor is covered in vinyl and there is a center rod storage box in the bow.

The Predator line has models 16, 17, 18 and 20' with the 2070 center console at the top measuring 20'long, 96" wide with a 20-gallon fuel cell and able to hold up to 150 hp and available in an olive drab or marsh grass exterior.

This boat is 20'2" long, 94" wide, weighs 2,000 pounds with a 50-gallong fuel capacity and capable of handling up to 250 hp. A properly rigged Z20 Pro runs around 68 mph. Standard features includes a Mercury Four Stroke Pro XS 250 with Torque Masterlowerunit, a Lowrance Ghost 36V trolling motor, a Lowrance HDS LIVE 9 flush-mounted fishfinder with StructureScan in the dash, a Lowrance HDS LIVE 9 gimbalmounted fish finder with ActiveTarget and Structure Scan on the bow (all three are NMEA networked), a five-inchin-dash digital touchscreen, dash light dimmer, Veethree multifunction instrumentation, a livewell culling system, factory applied keep protector, Hot Foot throttle, a fourbank battery charger, one extra trolling battery, twin 19-gallon Guardian livewells, twin rear storage compart-

ments, padded front deck, Z-CORE seating system, a center bow tackle management system compartment, port and starboard side rod locker, two molded aft storage boxes that hold seven 3700 tackle boxes, a lift out tray for tool/rope storage in battery compartment, insulated aluminum storage lids with welded corners, passenger rod ramp with rod handle organizer and hold down strap, a NOCO GB40 jump starter pack, LED lighted bow storage, below console RAM X-Grip phone holder and 12V outlet, Step to bow deck w/62-qt. (58.67 L) insulated cooler, removable trash receptacle & snap-in sandwich tray, hull integrated port and starboard running lights and a twin axle trailer.

Gary Glouse has spent a lifetime fishing professionally and building boats. His Phoenix bass boat line has become popular among area anglers. The flagship is the PHX 21. This boat is 21'6", 96" wide, weighs 1,950 pounds, holds 50 gallons of fuel and accommodates up to 250 hp.

Ranger

The flagship of Johnny Morris' boat brands has two traditional bass boat model lines to choose from: the Z Comanche Series and The Z Series hulls. The only fully new rig for 2024 is the Z518, Ranger Cup Equipped edition. The Z518 is a nice option for those wanting a Ranger but not the premium price associated with the brand. Add all the Ranger Cup option and you have an 18'10" long, 97" wide, 1,650-pound boat that sells for around \$56,000 (with a 150 hp) but will hold up to 200 hp and 39 gallons of fuel. include a Lowrance HDS-9 Live with Active Target on the bow, Lowrance HDS-9 Live at the console with Active Imaging, an onboard Dual Pro auto detect lithium capable battery charger, Lowrance Ghost 24V trolling motor, Hot Foot Throttle, a center rod box in the bow deck with rod management system, tool holders at the bow and front deck step, USB charging port and 12V receptacle, plus special 55th anniversary badging.

Ranger's top 20' hull would be the Z520R at 20'11", 96" wide and able to accommodate up to 250 hp. That boat will set you back around \$80K. The Ranger Z519 is 19'9" long, 97" wide and holds up to 225 hp and sells for around \$64,000.

Skeeter

Is the Skeeter ZXR20 the best value in tourna-

ment bass boats? Some would say it is. This boat is 20'4" long, 97" wide, weighs 2,275 pounds with a 48-gallon fuel capacity and holds up to 250 hp. Properly set up, the boat should run over 70 mph.

Numerous standard fishing features put the ZXR20 in a standard-setting class including a cavernous center tackle storage compartment on the front deck flanked by a port side rod locker and a rodlocker/storage compartment on the starboard side as well as a go to storage compartment. There are two bucket seats with a middle seat area that has storage underneath. The passenger has a slotted rod storage area with a trash receptacle. To access the front deck there's a two step area with tool storage on either side. Twin aerated livewells are tucked just inside twin storage compartments in the rear deck. A split compartment accesses the

Standard with the ZXR20 is a Yamaha V MAX SHO 250 four stroke outboard, Hot Foot throttle, a Minn Kota Ultrex iPilot 112 trolling motor, two 8' Minn Kota Raptors (an option on other packaged rigs), a Humminbird Helix 12 CHIRP MEGA SI GPS G4N with temperature in the dash, a Helix 9 CHIRP MEGA DI GPS G4N with temperature on the bow (both are gimbal mounted) a twin axle trailer, two bike seats, Hamby Keel Protector, Minn Kota 10 amp 5-bank charter, dry dock ventilation system, LED storage compartment lighting and eight color choices. The cockpit and boat switches are rocker style for assured performance.

This boat sells for around \$76,000 NAP so if you are in the market for such a feat of engineering, you'll want to check around for a boat with similar features.

The Skeeter lineup of bass boats consists of the ZXR hulls (ZXR21, ZXR20 and ZXR19), the FXR hulls (FXR 21 APEX, FXR 20 APEX, FXR 21 L and FXR 20 L) and the ZX 200 and ZX 150.

Tracker

The Tracker Pro Team 175 TXW remains one of the most popular fishing boats in the nation. At 17'7"long, 89"wide, a package weight of just 2,235 pounds, 21.5-gallon fuel capacity and able to hold up to 75 hp, the Pro Team 175 TXW sells for around \$24,000 (with a 60 hp) and \$25,715 with the 75 hp outboard. Tracker is now powdercoat painting and clearcoating this boat with what they dub the Diamond Coat 3.0 process, so they have better curb appeal and durability. The 2024 Tracker boats can be found at Dee Kidd's Anna's Marine Center at Lake Anna. www.annasmarinecenter.com.

Triton

The 2024 Triton 20XP Patriot is 20'5" long, 95" wide, weighs @2,220 pounds, with a 50-gallon fuel capacity and handles up to 250 hp. The total package weight comes in at under 3,000 pounds. According to Triton it will run past 70 mph. A rededication to performance drove the engineering for this new boat. To accomplish this, designers moved the center of gravity back nine inches to get the boat up and moving in a hurry. Inside, the cockpit features a full roster of innovations including the TriTouch[™] touchscreen control unit that offers insight into critical engine functions and performance and proven rocker switches for accessories. An integrated console shelf lets you mount two big screen graphs at the helm and all-new seating adds plush comfort and support. The cockpit floor is covered in hydro turf instead of carpet and features a Pro Pedal foot throttle.

Standard features include Lowrance® HDS fishfinders (Lowrance HDS 12 PRO with Active Imaging HD 3 in 1 transducer in the dash and a Lowrance | continued on page 20

num boats on the water. All models are built using all welded aluminum and the wings transom design that creates superior handling, even in choppy waters.

Since 1992, War Eagle Boats have been a force in the duck hunting industry, providing customers with the best camo paint jobs in the business. Each boat is individually painted using a tested process that produces HD camo results that blend perfectly with your environment. 

his is the time of year when many anglers are adding to their tackle arsenal. Most restock with proven producers and then review the new stuff they've heard the pro sare using and make some choices. Some trends we are seeing is a host of new reel manufacturers – too numerous to mention, but don't be surprised to see some reels with names like Seviin and Denali you've not seen before in shops this year. From ABU Garcia to ZOOM, here's a preview of some of what you'll see in shops, online and on the pro's boats this season.

ABU Garcia

The ABU Garcia Zenon X spinning reel looks to be a popular choice among area anglers this season that excels in finesse fishing techniques while offering the versatility to also handle heavier baits. The reel features an asymmetric, one-piece, lightweight aluminum gear box, Air fin spool design helps reduce weight, a V-Rotor design that reduces start up inertia, a carbon fiber handle and co-molded handle knob, a AMG2 fully machined aluminum main gear that gives unparalleled smoothness and durability, 9+ HPCR bearing system, 6.2:1 gear ratio for around 6 ounces in all versions.

Berkley

Offering anglers the durability and performance of a plastic bait, the new Berkley Dime crankbait is said to feature balsa-like action thanks to Berkley's patented Flash Disctechnology. It not only casts further due to the weight transfer system in the smaller sizes, but it tracks perfectly and features sticky sharp Fusion19 treble hooks. The bait comes in a number of intricate and modern color options to match the hatch that balsa baits cannot achieve. The bait is available in four sizes.

The Berkley Nessie is a new swimbait that resembles the Megabass Magdraft baits. The Nessie is available in three different sizes starting from five-inch up to nine-inches, the PowerBait Nessie presents a big profile with the ability to be retrieved at various speeds and cadences due to the unique stabilizing fins that keep the bait running consistent at all times (it doesn't roll). This bait has a mesh reinforced joint and hook retention clip so it's very durable. Anglers will enjoy skipping it under docks on clear area lakes.

Bill Lewis

The Hammer-Trap is the newest offering from Bill Lewis in the lipless category, which they put on the map over 50 years ago. The Hammer-Trap's name is derived from the incredible hammering action. This action, which will literally rock your rod tip, also activates the Tri-Tone sound chambers. In turn, this emits 3 distinct tonal frequencies as well as the next-level vibration. When stopped on the retrieve, the Hammer-Trap will fall with a fluttering action. The Hammer-Trap, which comes in 3/8 and 5/8-ounce is available in 16 pro-selected colors and comes equipped with Mustad Triple Grip hooks.

Culprit

The Culprit Shakin' Neko Craw looks to be a hot bait for this spring, the first of its kind

for use in finesse applications of Neko rigging, shakey head, wacky rigs, and even trimmed down for Ned rigs. When rigged Neko style, each twitch of the rod produces an action much like the tail of a crawfish as it scoots in short bursts on the bottom. There is even a built-in groove to securely hold an O-ring, popular with Neko and wacky rigging.

Costa Del Mar

Costa's new King Tide sunglasses are built for those who seek performance from their eyewear both on and off the water. For the first time in Costa's history, this frame is available in two styles – King Tide 6, a six-base frame with a straighter wrap and King Tide 8, a full wrap-around eight base version, giving elite watermen and anglers a choice in style and fit at the highest level of functionality.

Technical specs on both frames include removable side shields for optimal use on and off the water, shark inspired venting to achieve a near impossible zero-fog effect, top of the line sweat management, and the introduction of non-skid hooding to keep your frames exactly where you set them, no matter the conditions.

Daiwa

Daiwa has a redesigned and incredibly affordable Tatula 100 that's ultra-ergonomic (fits in your hand nicely). The first upgrade is a new, thinner and lighter 7075 aircraft-grade aluminum spool for greater casting distance and more control. Ultimately, Daiwa created a farther-casting reel with better braking system. Daiwa also went to what they call Hyperdrive gearing found in their higher end models like Steez and Zillion. MSRP is \$179.

MEGABass

Achieving overwhelming long-distance castability that exceeds the average flight distance of similar 70mm jerkbaits, the Megabass X-Nanahan jerkbait features a unique shape that provides excellent swimming response and intuitive handling. The X-Nanahan's body is carved from a high-volume block to create a visually tight silhouette with high precision. The X-Nanahan concept fuses the ideals of Shinjin Sato, one of Japan's foremost jerkbait anglers, and the engineering of Yuki Ito, creator and lure designer of dominant jerkbaits like the Vision 110. Bursting to life with dynamic jerking and darting action that sets it apart from the school, the X-Nanahan produces high-pitched rolling action on a straight retrieve and sharp dynamic darting action when twitching.

The MEGABass SHADING-X R62 is fueled by a patented balancer system that, despite its small 2.4in, 3/16oz size, enables dizzyingly high-pitch action and improved cast performance, elevating the finesse shad category to new heights. Reengineered to perform in the toughest conditions, the SHADING-X R62 is built to deliver bites when bass are keyed on precise, high-pitch action and smaller offerings. range of the original bigbody KANA-TA jerkbait. Now reaching depths of 10+ft, the KANATA+1 exhibits a high-pitch natural rolling action and a big, showstopping flash-and-dart action not found in other oversized jerkbaits. Comingin at 6.3 in, 1-1/80z, KANATA+1 features a tungsten Triple Oscillating System (PAT.) to propel the bait to the farthest reaches to hunt new targets.

MES Lures

The creative mind of Mike Seal produces many creations. The MES Lures Root Frog continues to be a local favorite among bass and snakehead anglers. Seal's fertile lure designing mind has created a floating frog with two sets of legs imitated by silicone strands both fore and aft of a hollow body. The colors are insane, especially the one featuring day glow orange. There are ³/₄ oz. hollow bodied versions as well as ¹/₄-oz. versions you'll want to try this season.

Rapala

This hard bait manufacturer has

introduced a line of soft baits called Crush City. There's the Bronco Bug, The Freeloader, the Ned BLT, The Cleanup Craw and The Mayor.

The new Bronco Bug differs from similar baits with a perfect level of body thickness, which allows an angler to Texas rig to keep it snagless, while allowing for easy penetration of the hook. It features a dolphin-like swimming action and a "Bronco Buck" kick when jigged. The body of the bait has raised ribs on each side to hide the hook point, meaning that when one side of the bait starts to show wear, the hook can be flipped without compromising any action, thereby increasing durability and efficiency. The appendages face forward, which means they'll create a disturbance larger than that of the overall package and remain quivering with the slightest bit of current or angler manipulation.

Collaborating with Jacob Wheeler, the product engineers at Rapala sought to create the ultimate chatterbait/spinnerbaittrailer bait. The new Crush City Freeloader can be used as a vibrating jig trailer, alone as a swimbait, or for countless other traditional and novel soft plastic presentations. The body features miniature ribs for added action, water movement and a realistic texture, but the unsung hero of this product is the tail, which tapers to a point, albeit one with a ball at the end. That creates a kicking action which is subtly realistic. It's the reason why it has quickly become Wheeler's spinnerbait trailer of choice, too, adding a bit of bulk, color contrast, and a touch of ultra-realism. 4 1/4inches long. 6-pack for \$5.99. 17 custom colors

The Rapala CrushCity[™] Ned BLT is a 3-inch tapered worm. It combines durability and high floating, while also retaining maximum action. It's built with TPE, so it's super-flexible and has some really good colors to it, but the key is that three inches is the perfect size whether you're dealing with largemouth bass, spotted bass or smallmouths. Available in 16 custom colors.

The Rapala OG Deep Tint 7 is a small, flat-sided crankbait made with premium balsa wood and circuit board lip. The flat-sided body design, combined with its balsa wood construction gives it a tight and finesse wobble. Getting the deep diving swim was a labor of love but pro angler and Rapala consultant Ott Defoe has perfected it in this new staple of cold water fishing. The new OG Deep Tiny 7 comes in 19 natural colors with a body length of 2-1/4 inches and weighs 5/16-ounce.

Strike King

The new Gravel Dawg crankbait delivers a wide wobble action in a bite-sized, 1.5 profile. It grinds through rock, wood, and grass better than any medium-diving crankbait in its class. The Gravel Dawg comes in two different versions – the Gravel Dawg 8 and Gravel Dawg 10. Both sizes keep the same body profile and size, but the bill changes between the two to achieve different diving depths. These baits will have you covered in the 5-10 ft. range throughout all parts of the country.

Shimano

Shimano designed the ARMA-JOINT 190SS Flash Boost (FB) to solve the challenges of casting a big jointed swimbait and the proprietary ARMABOOST technology significantly increases casting distance and accuracy by reducing unnecessary air resistance and the chances of the lure spinning during flight. As the angler casts the lure, ARMABOOST technology facilitates the lure to disconnect from an internal magnet and forces the body to fold into its compact shape. Once the lure hits the water, the lure's body reengages with the magnet to create a smooth and natural swimming action. Swim in an S-pattern, but the bait will not flare out when stopped due to the fold in its body. ARMAJOINT also features Shimano's proprietary FLASH BOOST technology that constantly emits a fish-attracting flash during the retrieve — even on the pause.

Shimano's Swagy spinnerbait incorporates an innovative taperedwire design to add durability without sacrificing the lure's vibration. The lower arm's thicker (0.95mm) wire improves hookup ratios and adds durability. SVS Infinity technology provides precision casting performance with easy-to-manage and consistent spool control and brake force adjustments when faced with demanding condi-



tions or switching between baits. The aluminum HAGANE Bodyprovides added rigidity to increase cranking power and overall reeling efficiency, while MicroModule Gear, Cross Carbon Drag and X-Ship deliver the tournament-tested smoothness, durability, and versatility for which the Curado family is known.

The newest addition to Shimano's CoreSolid lineup of spinning reels is the Stradic FM and it showcases reel technologies passed down from Shimano's flagship spinning reels. The addition of InfinityDrive delivers light rotation and increased cranking power under load, while the new Duracross Drag system provides the smooth performance of felt with up to 10 times the durability. Shimano's X-Protect water-repellent coating and specially designed, water-channeling labyrinth construction ensure a lifetime of dependable performance by stopping water penetration in key areas without adding a heavy rotational feel. The new Anti-Twist Fin — an elastic polymer on the underside of the roller — enhances line management for anglers fishing monofilament or fluorocarbon line.

Snagproof

Last year's Hot Cherry Crawis a custom-painted medium diving crankbait similar to a Bandit 100 that anglers snapped up like free beers at a football game. The new Electric Bluegill color pattern continues to drive demand from anglers wanting a Bagley-type crankbait in this outstanding color.

Yamamoto

The Yamatanuki 2.5 repeatedly requested by pros and consumers



The hook was custom designed by Z-Man pro Stephen Browning, including exclusive barb placement for optimal performance, hookset to lip-lock. Wire-tied 100% silicone skirting maxes out durability. Stainless steel blades sport extra durable plated, painted and glitter finishes. Available in 3/8- and 1/2-ounce sizes in 12 elite color patterns.

Zoom

Building upon the success of the widely popular Zoom Horny Toad, the Zoom Uni-Toad Swimbait is molded with the same body but with a single paddle tail instead of two Ultra-Vibe legs. On the bottom it features a belly slit to increase hook penetration and make it easy to rig weedless on EWG or screw-lock style hooks for fishing over grass and pads. It can also be fished as a trailer on the back of your favorite buzzbait to create better casting performance and a bigger target than a silicone skirt for hungry bass. What's New? OUTBOARDS

utboard manufacturers are now looking ahead to the year 2050, which some have announced as their goal to be carbon neutral. Yamaha in particular has said this is a goal and they are not only working on electric outboards but hydrogen power motors as well.

There are some electric outboards available, but nothing yet for the likes of today's high performance bass boats. Mercury is in the marketplace as are a host of smaller companies. Like most technological innovations in the marine industry the exciting stuff happens at the top and takes a while to trickle down to the mass market. There might be a scattering of electric powered vessels in anchorages these days, but no doubt as technology progresses and prices decline, we will see more and more boats sporting electric outboards, big and small.

For 2024 don't expect any groundbreaking introductions. The OEMs are sticking with their proven four stroke V6 and V8 designs for now and that means most boats you'll see at the show will be power by Mercury or Yamaha outboards with smattering of Hondas and Suzukis. Here's what's going on with the top outboard manufacturers for 2024.

Honda

While they are still somewhat of a rarity on bass boats around the area, Honda outboards are an option and they are present on pontoon boats and some coastal boats. The BF 200, BF 225 and BF 250 are Honda's V6, four-stroke outboards suitable for bass boats. They are built on a 60-degree, 24 valve V6 that displaces 3.5L and weighs 609 pounds. This outboards has a 90 amp (1119 amp) alternator with 60 watts of charging power. The cowling features air intake vents and is available in white and silver options. A unique cooling system passes through each aluminum exhaust manifold, the cylinder heads, and once again through the exhaust manifolds. This results in increased cooling efficiency and long-term durability. Honda's exclusive Intelligent Shift and Throttle (iST) command and control system delivers superb control plus plug-and-play installation of Honda Marine products and third-party controls and devices. Boosted Low Speed Torque, or BLAST, uses Honda's patented spark advance system to propel the boat to plane in just seconds. When you move the throttle quickly, BLAST is activated:

the throttle body opens up, the air-fuel ratio goes to a richer setting, the ignition timing advances aggressively and this allows the engine to make more torque, or power.

Mercury

The Pro XS line of Mercury outboards continue to be a popular option for the region's anglers. A large dealer network and being the exclusive outboard for certain boat manufacturers tends to help Mercury be the top choice on most boats you see on area waters.

The Mercury Pro XS 250 is what is found on the back of all new 21' Nitro's and Tritons. This V8 outboard displaces 4.6L and weighs just 511 pounds. It runs fine on 87 octane fuel with 10% ethanol maximum. The power plant's alternator cranks out an impressive 85 amps or (1,071 watts) wide open and 20 amps at idle to charge your battery. A DTS Hot Foot throttle is standard with all 200-300 Pro XS outboards. These motors are Smart-Craft capable and that means you can hook up any number of add-on accessories like Active Trim, VesselView Link and VesselView Mobile to increase performance and monitor the engine. Mercury claims the Pro XS 250 has better 0-20 mph acceleration on a heavily loaded 21' bass boat than a competitor's 250 hp (probably Yamaha), 12-15% more torque

and a higher top speed rigged on a 21' bass boat with a light load.

Mercury is putting a lot of research and development into its Avator electric outboard as regu lations around the globe are incentivizing nonfossil fuel motors. The Avator 7.5e debuted last year, offering 3.5 hp for small boats. New for 2024 is the Mercury Avator 20e and 35e. The 20e is said to be able to accelerate a 12' Lund WC-12 boat at a similar rate as a 5 hp four stroke outboard, while the 35e model's acceleration is similar to a 9.9 four stroke.

The Avators have displays on the front of the outboards that show battery life and settings. You can also connect wirelessly to yourphone using the SmartCraft Connect and Mercury Marine app. You can charge the lithium ion batteries individually using the charging port on each battery or charge up to four connected batteries at once using the Mercury Power Center charge port. The 230W charger takes 10 hours to fully charge a depleted 2300Wh battery. The 520W charger cuts that time in half.

Suzuki

Only limited by its lack of dealers in the region, Suzuki has a good product for area anglers to consider when repowering and when they are able to choose an outboard for a new boat. The revised Suzuki SS 250 engine offers a sleek cowling design featuring new intake louvers, upper cover grips (to assist with removing the cowling) and the new "SS" graphics include the raised black Suzuki lettering that is only featured on this model. It looks like a stealth or black ops engine.

The SS 250 is a V6 four stroke that displaces 245.6 cu. in. (4.0L) and weighs 578 pounds. It has a 54 amp alternator, Multi-Point Sequential Fuel Injection, Variable Valve Timing and Multi Stage Induction. Suzuki also offers fly-by-wire digital technology SPC 2.0 controls and Auto-Trim, a keyless start system and a digital pedal throttle. There's a new lower unit for less drag and the skeg has something called "left-right asymmetry" with a curve in it to assist in maneuvering.

Tohatzu

Better known for powering smaller boats and rental fleets, Tohatzu motors does field an option for the region's anglers needing an engine to push their bass boat. The Tohatzu BFT250D is a 3.6L V6 four stroke outboard with a narrow, 60-degree V6 design that weighs in at 619 pounds and has a 90 amp alternator with 60 charging amps. The BFT250 has another industry-first; separate dual air circuits. The first is used to cool the engine where air is drawn into the front of engine and *continued on page 41*

here really aren't any jawdropping headlines in marine electronics coming in 2024. Garmin does have a new trolling motor as does Minn Kota (finally joined other manufacturers with brushless technology), and Lowrance will introduce a newer version of live sonar. Here's what you can expect to see at the shows and in shops this season.

Garmin

The new Garmiun Force® Kraken trolling motor will be available this spring. Dubbed the most powerful trolling motor the recreational fishing market has ever seen. Coupled with Garmin's industry standard precise anchor lock technology, Kraken is designed with longer shaft lengths and a pivot-style mount for easy installation on boats where bow space is limited; like skiffs, bay boats, center consoles and multispecies fishing boats.

Garmin's newest trolling motor utilizes multi-band GPS signal reception and integrated AHRS (attitude and heading reference system) for heading hold to deliver Garmin's most precise boat positioning technology yet. "We are excited to build on the success of our Force trolling motor and bring new mounting options and features to even more anglers in both the saltwater and inland markets. From power and durability to integration and innovation, Kraken has everything anglers want and need from their trolling motor and more," said Dan Bartel, Garmin VicePpresident of Global Consumer Sales.

And with the Kraken, for the first time in the industry, anglers can install forward-facing sonar, like LiveScope[™], on a pivot-style trolling motor by conveniently routing the transducer cable **inside** the trolling motor shaft thanks to Kraken's new LiveScope cable management system.

With the Kraken LiveScope Mounting Bracket (additional purchase required), any LiveScope transducer can be installed and operated in all three modes—forward, down and perspective. This will keep the LiveScope cable safe from possible damage during stow or deploy and keeps the trolling motor and deck space cleaner.

Kraken's brushless motor uses a highefficiency propeller to produce 100 pounds of thrust on a 36-volt system, or 80 pounds on a 24-volt system. Even with all that power, Kraken is extremely efficient so anglers can count on it to fish all day. It's also whisper quiet above and below the water and less likely to spook the fish.

In calm conditions, the Krakenwill decelerate the motor when it's within approximately one meter of the user-selected location. And in rough conditions, Kraken can apply more aggressive motor speed for improved performance on larger boats.

Wireless integration with Garmin chartplotters allows anglers to create routes, patterns and tracks for the trolling motor to follow while they fish, and a new illuminated arrow on the trolling motor head can allow anglers to confirm the boat's heading at a glance (a simple, but very important feature).

Anglers can also use the included wireless remote to help navigate from anywhere in the boat. The remote can give anglers control of the Kraken trolling motor with precise virtual anchor lock, autopilot functionality, heading hold and point-and-go gesture steering—plus itfloats. A compatible Garmin smartwatch, like the award-winning quatix[®] 7 series, can also be connected to Kraken to control steering, anchor lock and more, right from the wrist.

Select Kraken models include a built-in GT56UHD all-in-one transducer with Ultra High-Definition ClearVü and SideVü scanning sonar along with CHIRP traditional sonar for brilliantimage clarity of structure and fish below and to the sides of the boat. Additional Garmin transducers can be added and no matter the sonar setup. The brushless motor technology allows for clear returns with extremely low levels of unwanted noise from electrical and mechanical interference. The Kraken propeller is designed with a thinner leading edge to reduce resistance and maximize thrust, while the trailing edge is engineered to decrease aeration of the water that can cause cavitation and interfere with thrust. Rugged and durable, the sturdy composite shaft and all components have advanced corrosion and saltwater protection. Krakens are backed by a three-year limited warranty and a lifetime limited warranty on the shaft, along with support through an ever-increasing servicing dealer network.

Kraken will be offered in white in 63-, 75- and 90-inch shaft lengths, or black in 63- and 75-inch lengths. Both black Kraken models are sold with a GT56UHD transducer. Suggested retail prices range from \$3699.99 to \$4299.99.

Humminbird

MEGA Live Imaging TargetLock combined with MEGA Live Imaging – a way to keep live imaging sonar always pointed at the target automatically was introduced mid model year 2023. Area anglers have sung its praises.

Combined with Minn Kota Ultrex[™], the need to choose between Spot-Lock[®] and MEGA Live Imaging is no longer. The new Humminbird MEGA Live Hand Control[™] Universal Mount allows anglers to utilize the technology on any vessel. For 2024 Humminbird will continue to rely on

Apex, Helix and Solix G4 fishfinder lines.

Lowrance

The new Lowrance HDS PRO system provides full networking and bow-to-stern boat control spanning trolling motors, autopilots, engines, radar, communications and PowerPole® shallow water anchors. It includes C-MAP® DISCOVER OnBoard charts, featuring high-res bathymetric 1-foot contours for over 19,000 lakes across the U.S. and 9,400 in Canada. A new chart option also allows users to overlay ActiveTarget 2 Scout or Ghost 360 trolling motor views, directly on the chart.



New Ways To Shoot Old Birds

BY KATE AHNSTROM

W ith the new year, we all eagerly welcome the chance to hit the "reset" button. This rebirth is a way to shake off the old and start anew. But, what if some of your old habits are the only thing you know? How do you break that cycle of consistent inconsistency in your shooting? Are you sure you are employing every tool in your toolbox to create success?

Shooters, like all humans, thrive on structure and discipline. Even those that claim they prefer a more loose and fast approach (shoot whatever you see however you can) deep down inside long for the coveted ability to know. Know why they can hit certain birds but not others. Know what they did wrong to cause a miss and most importantly know how to fix it!

This new year, make a commitment (one that will actually last unlike all the diet challenges) and learn new ways to crush those old, irritating presentations. Too many shooters get mired down in just one or two methods of shooting. They either aren't willing to learn a new method, or they may not realize that there are other methods to kill a bird, clay or feathered.

There are five distinct methodologies a shooter will pull from based on the presentation. Please remember

First, and most commonly used is Pull Away. This method is rooted deeply in the West London Shooting School for a very good reason. It works! At the hold point, the shooter will insert on the bird, go with it for just a moment and then pull ahead and pull the trigger. Let's break this method out a little further, since it is the backbone for so many shooters.

The hold point needs to be in or slightly under the flight path of the bird. As the bird comes to the barrel, the gun begins to move out with the bird maintaining the flight path. At the determined break point, the shooter pulls ahead of the bird the required distance based on angle and speed. As they pull the trigger, the bird shatters. The majority of your birds can be killed with Pull Away.

Second, Swing Through. This is one of my favorite methods for quickly eliminating a bird in a pair. It's also fantastic for dropping multiple feathered birds in a covey. Again, the barrel has to be in the bird's flight path. The hold point for this method is set closer to the launch area so that the bird can easily pass the barrel. As the bird passes the barrel, the shooter pushes the gun through the back of the bird,

moving to the front and as the shooter comes through the front of the bird, pulls the trigger. Measuring is not needed as the pure motion of the gun adds in the required lead. This method will allow a shooter to drop a bird far faster.

Third, Churchill. Yes, as in Robert Churchill. He realized that if one could quickly point at an object with their shotgun, the same way they do their finger, they should be able to drop game. This is all dependent on the shooter having a well-fitted gun, a clean sight picture and smooth mount to the cheek and shoulder. This method is deadly on flushing game up to 25 yards. It falls apart after that as the presentation at distance will require lead or adjustment for angle.

Fourth, Maintained/Sustained Lead. Skeet shooters know this method well. The shooter needs to, you guessed it, be in the bird's flight path but this time, the shooter pulls ahead of the bird and stays ahead of the bird while pulling the trigger. It's a great method to use when the shooter is either very experienced in reading the target for speed and angle or the shooter is very well versed in repetitive shots, such as on a skeet field.

Finally, Straight Line Intercept. This is sometimes also referred to as Diminishing Lead. The shooter sets up in the bird's path makes a momentary connection with the bird then instead of continuing the flight line with the bird, the shooter runs the barrel a significant distance under the flight line and intercepts the bird at the break point. It works wonderfully on chandelles! No matter your preferred method, branch out and have fun learning new ones. There is more than one way to crush a clay or drop a feathered bird. Fill your toolbox and give yourself the advantage. Be sure to take a friend or family member along so they can learn along with you! Happy New Year everyone and see you on the course or in the hunt field.


Returning, Ish calls his most important sponsors, those paying the most. He stays in touch with sponsors all season. "They know what I'm

Frequently courted by potential sponsors, Ish builds a mutually beneficial relationship. Ish is fair to existing sponsors, committed to putting forth 100% effort. Adding new ones would compromise the time commitment made to core sponsors.

Younger anglers tout social media numbers. Ish says social media alone doesn't sell product. Companies want sales. Easily measured results set him apart. He's supported by top line sponsors: Skeeter Boats, Yamaha Outboards, Lowrance Electronics, Simms Fishing, Diawa, Sportsman's Warehouse, and others.

Prior to his tuna trip, Ish ordered rods, reels, and line from Diawa, as he works across spon-



sor product lines. Sorting through every lure box, Ish replaces, replenishes, and reorders everything he's going to use. Lures have a 3 year lifespan. If not used in three years, they're set aside. Hooks are replaced. Anything else, he picks up at Fisherman's Warehouse. Previous season's gear is donated to high schools and bass clubs.

"I would love to have those kids use that gear and get excited about going fishing."

Ish received his new Skeeter in November, giving him two weeks to rig. Replacing the factory jackplate, with a BOB's jackplate, Ish installs the Lowrance Ghost trolling motor, Lowrance electronics, and Power Poles. Installing accessories minimizes troubleshooting.

"You don't know who's working on your boat. Rather blame me than try to figure out what someone else did."



Local anglers know that the fishing on the Chickahominy system can be very good for big fish this time of year. While you might not catch dozens of bass now, you do have an excellent shot at a eight+ pounder in the upper river and lake.

Some traditional areas to look for winter bass on the tidal Chickahominy River include the backs of lower river creeks like Morris, Tomahund, Gordon's, Shipwreck and Yarmouth. Largemouth bass will school by the dozens in deeper creek bends with wood. You can target them with a three-inch Keitech Swing Impact Fat on a 1/4-oz. jighead or a similar bait on a drop shot rig.

In the upper Chickahominy, you'll still want to target the region from the first big bend up from Riverside Camp up to Walker's Dam. In this region, savvy anglers know hundreds of fish school in the deep channel bends. Don't be afraid to fish 18' of water with blade baits like a Riverside Ripper or Crazy Blade. Many species are harbored in this deep water including largemouth bass, crappie, yellow perch and catfish.

Yellow perch and crappie will school around Walker's Dam this month, too. Be careful to observe safe fishing practices around this structure. Crappie love the concrete and wood structure in the water here where the river is separated from the lake.

When you are on the river this year, use Riverside Camp & Marina's facilities which include a fine boat ramp and piers, tackle shop and campground with rental cabins. Rockahock Campground welcomes anglers with ramps on both the lake and river, plus rental cabins and yurts.

Up on the lake, Ed Allen's Boats & Bait is fishing headquarters on the lower end of the lake. Here you'll find a boat ramp, jon boat rentals, minnows, tackle shop, restaurant

and fishing pier.

In nearby Toano, a bit down Rt. 60 there's a great gun shop and an awesome tackle shop. The wife might want to accompany you. Drop her off at the nearby Williamsburg outlets. Reconvene for lunch or dinner at the waterfront Lakeside Restaurant at Ed Allen's.

Toano General Gun Store is area headquarters for hunters and firearms enthusiasts. Don Bishard can help you with everything from long guns to handguns, accesories to ammunition and in-house gunsmithing.

Lin Bell's Fishing ProTech is also a Must-Do when in town. Bell specializes in hard-to-find and new bass tackle. Bell will take his shop on the road to the Richmond Fishing Expo, January 19-21 at the Meadow Event Park in Doswell. He's coming in hot with a load of special run color ZOOM baits, Megabass Visions and MagDrafts, Shimano Flash Boost baits, Crush City baits, Hover rig gear, the Elite EVO Chatterbait and more. C.C. Bell says the crappie fishing will continue to be strong this month on wood and bridge pilings in and around the mouth of Appomattox River. Bass anglers will want to explore the Appomattox River this winter as many bass over-winter in it, off the James River.

One of his favorite tactics is pitching a creature bait to wood on deep banks on a warm afternoon. Google Earth the Appomattox all the way up to Colonial Heights and note some good fishing areas to try this month. Check with Bell on launch ramps and current river conditions. The schedule for Bell's James RiverTackle Co. Weekend Series Bass Trail is as follows: March 23, April 6, April 20, June, July 13 and August 10. The Two-Day Classic will be held September 28-29. All of these events are held on the tidal James River out of Hopewell Marina.

Bell says tidal James catfish anglers know January is a month for big blues. Cut live shad fished on bottom rigs or live eels are gobbled

readily by blue catfish up to 80 pounds now.

Over on Lake Chesdin, anglers are discovering that the saugeye DWR has been stocking the past few years are doing well. Visitors are catching them exceeding the minimum size limit of 18 inches using swimbaits reeled slowly along the bottom at the mouths of creeks with rockypoints and bait.

Chesdin bass anglers should target some of the biggest bass of the year using suspending jerkbaits and spoons this month.

Chesdin striper are feeding heavily now. You can find them under birds on main lake flats in the mornings and in main lake pockets in the afternoons.

Area bowhunters, if you busted something on your bow or crossbow last month, you need to stop by Pat's Sporting Goods south of Richmond on Rt. 1. This shop offers bow hunting and archery enthusiasts a skilled bow technician who has years of experience setting up and repairing archery equipment.

Hunters west of Mechanicsville will want to stop by Jo Jo's Fishin' & Huntin' Express in Manquin. This shop is well-stocked with everything you'd need for a successful day deer hunting or waterfowling.


The Yamaha 250, 225 and 200 V MAX SHO outboards are found on all Skeeter bass boats and the brand is a popular option among coastal anglers. The V MAX SHO 250 is a 60-degree V6 with 4.2L of displacement that weighs 567 pounds and offers 70 gross amps with an optional isolator that can charge a house or trolling batteries. The engine design features individual intake and exhaust camshafts, larger valves than previous models and four valves per cylinder for better valve timing, responsive power and increase fuel economy. This outboard requires minimum 89 octane fuel.

Yamaha's exclusive In-Bank Exhaust System exits downward through the center of the V block rather than on the exterior. This increases efficiency, power and torque while resulting an a more compact shape.

Yamaha says the V MAX SHO 250 is faster to 50' than a competitor's 250 (think Mercury) by .15 sec., .19 sec faster to 100' and .28 seconds faster to 200'.



REGIONAL FOCUS

As predicted, much-needed rainfall brought Lake Anna water levels and water temperatures back to normal last month. This also brought to a close a very good up lake striper/ wiper feed. Annual baitfish migrations from up lake into the mid lake region are now underway and the lake's bass, striper and wiper are tracking them. Here's what you can expect for a January visit.

According to guide C.C. McCotter, lower water temperatures and muddy water up lake mean striper, wiper, bass, white perch, crappie, even catfish have moved into the lower up lake and mid lake regions. The game fish simply followed the schools of threadfin shad. Where the shad hold up is a based on a combination of water temperature, plankton and depth.

The key to finding these schools of winterfish is being vigilant, McCotter notes.

"Watch for any little sign of gamefish pressuring bait like swirls, bait jumping out of the water, sudden movements of seagulls and herons," he told W2. "Of course, I'm always watching my Humminbirds as well."

When you do catch a clue of where to fish,

it's go time. McCotter suggests vou trv ZOOM Super Fluke Jr on a jig head, threeinch swimbaits on an A-rig, a bucktail, a suspending jerkbait and a spoon. These are the baits he uses each year to catch striper, wiper, bass and white perch. If you want to focus exclusively on catching the big wintertime bass Anna is known for producing, focus your efforts mid lake, says McCotter and use suspending jerkbaits, swimbaits, underspins and spoons.



Seth Henderson joined guide C.C. McCotter out of *High Point Marina - Lighthouse Inn* for a winter fishing trip and they found the bass hungry for their Fitt Premium Lures River Darters. All fish released.

Bass are schooled now. You should be able catch them jigging spoons in 27-35' of water at the mouth of Pigeon, Mitchell and Sturgeon Creeks. Some of the more adventurous/aggressive bass can be caught using a suspending jerkbait around main lake points in the same region.

Hot zones here can include the mouth of Marshall Creek, the mouth of Pigeon Creek, Mitchell Creek, the mid section of Contrary Creek and the mouth of Sturgeon Creek.

Unless the water clears up and warms up considerably, you can pretty much write off up lake bass until March.

Down lake bass are creatures of the deep that occassionally enjoy a mass foray into shallow pockets and up on shallow points. Most of the best places to target these bass are the points at the mouths of down lake creeks (Beaver Pond,

Boggs, Dukes, Rockland, Blount's, Levy and Valentine's) as well as the coves near Dike III. Swimbaits, reeled slowly along the bottom are effective down lake as are suspending jerkbaits. Mid lake bass tend to school in creeks due

to clearer water. Hot zones here can include



the mouth of Marshall Creek, the mouth of Pigeon Creek, Mitchell Creek, the mid section of Contrary Creek and the mouth of Sturgeon Creek. Using swimbaits, hard and soft plastic swimbaits can be effective when fish and bait are in the area otherwise go deep with spoons and blade baits.

Many anglers are now employing forward facing live sonar to "snipe" bass they see on their screens. The pattern here is to find underwater rocks and brush, cast a bait like the new Berkley Power Switch and let it sink to the level of the fish. The screen will tell you if the fish is interested!

Keep in mind the schools of bass can move from very deep to shallow throughout the day. So if your depth finder shows fish in 28-32 of water at the mouth of a creek where you caught them shallow in the morning, don't doubt it.

Good to excellent fishing is available now for Lake Anna's striped fish. Anglers will find most in the mid lake region after they fed actively in the upper the North Anna River and Pamunkey Branch for much of last month. Striper and wiper will relocate mid lake around baitfish and you might also find schools right around the 208 marinas. Evening fishing at Dike 3 can also be productive in January.

Look for some remaining schools to linger from the Holladay Mill Bridge down to Big Been Flats in the North Anna side and from Stubbs Bridge down to The Splits in the Pamunkey Branch. Some fish might remain in The Splits region to 208 marinas region, too. Don't overlook the mouths of Contrary and Pigeon Creeks either in January.

McCotter is happy to report a lot of the non-keeper striper and wiper (under 20") in the lake have now grow to 21-22" and there are some bruisers out there with January often when anglers catch the year's largest fish. Could a 15-lb. + wiper be coming this winter? We'll have to fish and see!

You can also often catch white perch in the same areas when the striper won't bite. The 1/4-oz. Capt. Mack's Super Spoon is deadly on all three and a blade bait is a lot of fun to fish for perch. The mouth of Pigeon Creek is usually a good place to target these tastyi fish. If they aren't there, check the mouth of Sturgeon Creek.

Some of the lake's crappie remained schooled around bridge pilings near the main river channel. Deep brush piles are good, too, if you can find one that hasn't been fished too often. Two-inch jigs on 1/16-oz. jig heads and small minnows on slip bobbers are best. This is the year anglers are again catching legal sized saugeye (18"). DWR Biologist Mike Isel told W2 gill net surveying revealed

good numbers of these tasty fish from a stocking four years ago. You can target saugeye on deep rocks with grubs, swimbaits and nightcrawlers on a worm harness. They will often hit the same lures you using for striper/wiper.

Tournament Director Dave Fauntleroy wanted to invite anglers to review his lineup of bass fishing tournaments in 2024. Check the Anna Point Marina website for event dates and stop by Fish Tales to chat with Fauntleroy.

High Point Marina and The Lighthouse Inn welcome winter anglers looking for a warm room and great access to the lake. The tackle shop is well-stocked with guide-selected items, including a restock of spoons, Megabass suspending jerkbaits and MagDrafts,

Elk Creek Country Store is where to find fuel and Uncle Mike's Tackle Shop on the way to fishing the warm side of the lake this month. Mike notes bass and perch were schooled in Elk and Millpond Creeks for much of December with water temperatures in the mid 50s to lower 60s. These fish will be moving toward warmer water every day and eventually end up in front of the Elk Creek and Millpond Bridges and Pond 1. Swimbaits, dropshots and spoon are all good now.Fish shallow when you see fish chasing bait, otherwide target 25-38' depths.

REGIONAL FOCUS Mountain Lake

Smith Mountain Lake level was 793.73' and rising slightly by the middle of December. This is higher than the level at the end of November. Keep in mind normal pond is 795' so the lake is remains a little low.

Water temperature was 46-49 degrees on the surface from mid to down lake by the mid-December W2 deadline. Expect the lake level to hold steady in January and watch the water temperature begin to drop into the lower 40s by the end of the month.

January can be a good month to fish the lake for largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, striper and crappie.

Most January largemouth bass will be caught around points, on rock piles, in brush piles and under docks. Best depths will be from the surface to 25 feet deep. Some largemouth bass will be schooled deep and on baitfish. You can pursue the differently, using spoons, spy baits, multi-arm rigs and plastic minnow imitators on Moon Eye heads.

The lake's smallmouth bass will be holding on rocks, ledges, humps and main channel points. Best lures will be Ned rigs, hair jigs, drop shot rigs and Carolina rigs. Focus your efforts on the mid to the lower sections of the lake, especially within sight of the dam. Wilson targets striper in the upper section of the lake this month, especially in larger creeks. His best lures are swimbaits, jigging spoons

and ZOOM flukes fished on 1/4 to 1/2 oz. jigheads. The best depths will be from near the surface to 50 feet deep. Vertical jigging with a

spoon remains a good method to catch stripers this month, too. Wilson says to try to find areas with the largest concentrations of baitfish.

Spike and Kathy Francescini operate Spike's PrimeTime Fishin', one of the longest continuously operated guide services in Virginia.

They are off until April now but are taking booking requests and thank all their 2023 customers for a great year!

They note the lake's striper population continues to grow and that January and February are two of the best months to land a citation (20+ pound) SML striper.

Many anglers will now fish alewives or shad on planer boards or freelines with 5/8 split shot 10 feet deeper than you see the fish. You can also fish down rods with 2 oz. sinkers exactly where you see the fish. Remember, you can now keep two fish per day under 30 inches or over 40 inches.

Give them a call if you want to trying fishing the lake this coming season. Not only do the Franceschinis offer guided fishing trips but they also rent lodging they own at the lake. Kathy's Place, 3 br/2b, sleeps eight with game room. The other rental is is a 2 br/1 bath, sleeps four with kitchen in the great room. Both have flat screen tvs and wifi and fully equipped kitchens. Guests enjoy use of the docks and also water, electric, cleaning stand and room to park boats. You also get use of a golf car with each rental to use to and from the docks. The listing #s are 218590 and 282712 on VRBO.





Lake Gaston

By mid-December the water level on Gaston was around 199.60' (200' is full pool) and Dominion was holding the level steady. Water temperatures ranged from 45-52 degrees with the up lake section just below Kerr Dam the coolest. Anglers can expect 38-45-degree water temperatures for January in most parts of the main lake.

For January on Gaston, long time BASS-Master Elite angler and guide Rick Morris will target deep bass schooled on bait using a jigging spoon. The lake's plentiful spotted bass will be mostly on hard cover like rocks and a little deeper. They will also take the spoon as well as a small soft plastic jerkbait fished on a jighead.

Lake Gaston can also offer good crappie and striper fishing this month. Target freckles on bridge pilings and deep brush piles. The lake's striper will school on bait and you'll have to keep an eye on seagulls to know where to go. Holly Grove Marina is a family-friendly tackle shop, boat ramp, restaurant/gathering place on the lake and we're glad to have them with us. Holly Grove is located about 10 minutes off I-95 at the Bracey exit on Rt. 903. Morris now has a fishing pontoon in addition

to his 21' bass boat for guiding larger parties.

Kerr Reservoir (Bugg Island)

The water level on Kerr Lake by the W2 late December deadline was 298.94' and rising. 300' is full pool. Daytime water temperatures

varied from 45-50 degrees depending on the region of the lake late last month.

This month anglers should expect continued drop in water temperatures - back down to around 38-44 degrees eventually.

Shad and herring are now on the main lake and still lingering at the mouth of some major creeks. Many anglers here use spoons on points now. Some like to use swimbaits. If you visit, you are mostly going to be targeting schooling bass, striper or crappie on or near baitfish. The suspending jerkbait bite could develop later this month, too.

If you cannot get a reaction bite, you can also try fishing shaky head worms and drop shotted

worms around 15-20' humps and points with underwater cover like rocks and brushpiles.

Fishing points in the larger creeks like Nutbush, Bluestone, Rudd's, Butcher's and Eastland as well as main lake points at the mouths of these creeks should be the pattern now.

Striper anglers are still fishing the Clarksville area where they are finding feeding fish under birds and busting bait.

Casters will want to use three-inch spoons like the KT Slab/Toothache spoon around the mouth of creeks and on main lake channel bends. Swimbaits or soft plastic jerkbaits on jigheads are also good where you find birds. Some striper anglers will troll umbrella rigs this month tipped with swimbaits.

Before you head out onto the lake, be sure to stop by Bobcat's Bait and Tackle to get a current fishing report and all the gear you could possibly need.

The third event of the 2023-24 Bobcats Bait & TackleVA/NC CrappieTrail was held December 2. The team of Tyler and Ricky Trent took first with 10.98 lbs and won \$1,336.

The remaining events will be held Jan. 27, Feb. 24 and March 9. The Classic will be held April 19-20. The circuit draws some of the best crappie anglers in the mid-Atlantic region.

Cold weather and shorter days are putting fish into winter patterns and that means it's a great time to fish the tidal Potomac River. Here's what you can expect if you get out this month.

Start by looking for steep drops. Take it slow, small, and light with grubs, tubes, thin small worms and hair jigs! Spinning gear handles lighter six-pound test on 10 pound test braid on fast spinning combos. Use thin wire hooks for hooks sets on cold fish from a longer distance on light line!

Crappie and bass are being caught in deeper spots on the tidal Potomac out of the current, like The Spoils, Smoot Bay and around the I-95 Bridge. DC Bridges are also spots to try, as is Washington Channel. The hot spots are Possum Point, Four Mile Run and Blue Plains, but they ican be very crowded! In these dischargers there are many shad and other species; it's hard to get baits through them. You need to "feel" fish before setting the hook!

Drop shots, split shots are good, but Carolina rigs with 1-ounce weights keep baits in one spot a long time, letting current push it. Generally, a five-inch finesse worm in green pumpkin or watermelon/ red works. Use the same baits on split shot and drop shot.

During heat of the day, near warmed rock and wood surfaces or close to Blue Plains, work suspending jerkbaits in clearer water 45 degrees or warmer...warmer the better...50 is very warm this time of the year. Use 10-pound fluorocarbon line. Jerk and pause... twitch...pause, twitch, and sit. Before you jerk, crank baits down first.

If water in other areas warms to 45, try crankbaits and spinner-

baits. For crankbaits, a tight wiggle bait is needed. Spool 10-pound test fluorocarbon and make long casts. Fish are not hitting very

hard, so crankbait hooks become critical.

Spinnerbaits, 3/8 ounce or heavier with willow/ Colorado gold blades, retrieved near flats out of current close to deeper drops, pausing when you don't feel the bottom, will work. Slow down with a slower reel or slow it down by slightly underspooling. White or white/ chartreuse skirts, best with chop on the water.

River bass are grouped on drops. Make bait transitions as fronts pass. Your temperature gauge is the most important boat instrument and your PFD the most important piece of gear. Dress in

layers, take a buddy and let others know where you are going to be. A fall into the river this time of year can be fatal!



The king of all winter river baits is the Silver Buddy! The company is making them again. Cast to three-foot depths and burp down drops to deeper water. Vertically jig over 8-15 foot holes. Don't overwork! Control drops on semi slack line back to bottom. Feel a "tick" or feel fish when you lift again.

For tackle, use a 7-foot medium action graphite rod and 10-pound test GAMMA Copoly. Replace dull hooks, cutting the eye near the shank, open, attach and close. Split rings allow hooks to catch each other. Blade baits locate groups of fish. Take note of depth and stay on them.

For bottom baits, try three: Mizmo Tubes, and 1/4-ounce Punisher Hair Jigs with plastic Punisher chunks. Thinner diameter line offers less resistance, encouraging fish to hold on longer. Thin diameter makes it easier to feel light bites and set hooks on longer casts, and gets to the bottom, holding in wind and current.

For three-inch avocado grubs (perfect replacement for stingray grubs), use 1/4-ounce round jig heads. Rig tails flat. Cast to bottom lifting the rod, slowly drop, creating a very slow gliding motion into cover. Green pumpkin Mizmo tubes rigged with a 1/4-ounce weedless insert tube head made with Mustad Hooks make this bait glide. Punisher Hair jigs.

Drop shotting becomes very effective the colder it gets, near 40 or below. Fish group on drops on South Point, Smoots, Spoils, barges above the Wilson Bridge, and Foxes Ferry. A good drop shot rod has enough backbone to hook set on long casts, but flexible enough when working under the boat. Capt. Steve Chaconas

Rapphannock River

Fishing was phenomenal last month on the tidal Rappahannock in the mid to upper section of the river. Smallmouth bass dominated the catches in recent weeks, with an occasional largemouth catch here and there. However, I anticipate a decline in the smallmouth bite and an increase in difficulty due to heightened fishing activity and old man winter.

As we enter 2024, it is crucial to consider water clarity, particularly when it changes due to weather conditions. Towards the end December the river received a lot of rain that caused high water levels and reduced water clarity. The water temperature has consistently been in the mid to low 40's with live bait and crankbaits being the bait of choice. Concentrate your efforts on river bends, submerged structures, and rocks. Utilize a slow presentation, like slow rolling a crankbait, soft plastics or live minnows to be effective throughout the month. Mike Hepburn

Bob's Fishing Hole continues to hold tournaments all winter long. Teams weigh a threefish limit and blast off at 8 am. In addition to the Winter Series, Bob's is also holding crappie tournaments. You can find out all the dates by visiting their Facebook page.

James notes Bob's Fishing Hole's winter bass anglers use jigs, jerkbaits and some drop shot to target fish over-wintering in the Northwest River from Back Bay.

For a January visit James says to stop in an he'll give you some tips on where to try fishing. Deep shoreline wood on the main river using creature baits and the drop shot has been productive. You can fish from spot to spot using the suspending jerkbait like a Megabass Vision 110 Minnow. River bends with a channel near a creek mouth are always good places to probe.

close to free boat ramps on Back Bay, the North Landing River (on site) and within a 20-minute drive to Bob's Fishing Hole.

North Bay Shore Campground is headquarters for North Bay or the upper portion of Back Bay behind Sandbridge.

Here you'll find the best ramp for all of North

Bay, especially if the NE wind blows and there's low water. From here you can access all the weedy "ponds" that are full of bass around North Bay and enjoy excellent crappie fishing in nearby Muddy and Hell's Creek.

North Bay Shore Campground welcomes anglers and has cabins and a bath house for overnight stays. A canal runs right behind the cabins, so you can keep your boat in the water! Best of all, the campground is 10 minutes from Sandbridge restaurants.

Backwater Adventures Guide David Ward guides on the North River, Kitty Hawk Bay and other northeastern North Carolina rivers. Ward says January fishing will be all about the weather. He notes the water temps should be in the 40's and somre days starting in the upper 30's.

Ward notes the bites will be fewer and slower, but this month will be a good time to catch a big one. Jigs and crankbaits will be the best choice. He suggests fishing very tight to wood and any other cover that could hold a little heat. Flatsides, Shad Raps and the Rapala DT-6 will cover you in the crankbait department this month.

REGIONAL FOCUS Chesapeake Bay

Middle Bay

Fishing for striped bass is now strictly catch and release and if you give it a whirl on a calm and sunny day, the fish are holding in the deepest parts of the shipping channel and to a lesser degree the False Channel. They are also tucked in like cordwood at the bottom at the Bay Bridge rock piles but unlikely to bite – best to just leave them alone. The warm water discharge at the Calvert Cliffs Power Plant will always get the attention of anglers during the cold winter months. Anglers may even find a speckled trout nosed into the warm water there if they're lucky.

White perch can be found deep in several areas in the middle Bay, usually around the 40-foot mark. Large white perch can be found at the rock piles at the Bay Bridge, holding deep in the swift current. It will take a heavy jig or dropper rig to get to them. The 40-foot channel edge out in front of Matapeake is another traditional area for white perch to be holding, before that edge drops off into 100 feet of water. You can find them on your depth finder be aware you may also detect schools of gizzard shad hunkered down in the same areas.

Lower Bay

If striped bass are your target this month, keep in mind all Maryland and Virginia waters of the Chesapeake are closed and only allow catch-and-release fishing for striped bass.

If you do focus on striped bass, the best action is occurring from the mouth of the Wicomico River south to the mouth of the Potomac along the channel edges. Bird activity can be sparse so keep a watchful eye

on a depth finder along the deeper channel edges. The section of the Potomac from the St. Marys River to Point Lookout is the best place to find diving gulls and breaking striped bass.

Jigging has been a very popular way to fish along the channel edges and anglers are using 1- to 1.5-ounce soft plastic jigs from 6-8 inches with good success. White and chartreuse colors are popular, braided line and a fast taper fishing rod are very helpful tools of the trade. Trolling is another option, and a warm cabin can offer an inviting way to fish. It will take stout trolling rods to handle the heavy inline weights needed to get bucktails, sassy shads, or umbrella rigs down to where the fish are holding.

Coastal

Tautog are providing fishing opportunities at the inlet jetties, the Route 50 Bridge piers, and nearby bulkheads. Sand fleas are the preferred bait. A fair percentage of the tautog being caught fail to meet the 16-inch minimum but the fishing is fun. The daily creel limit for tautog is four per day.

Now that the black sea bass season is closed, tautog are also the focus at the nearshore and offshore wreck and reef sites. Most anglers are doing well and some double-digit size tautog are being caught. Pieces of green crab and white-legger crabs along with sand fleas are the baits of choice.

Eastern Shore

Call Capt. Pete Wallace if you want to experience the legendary waterfowl hunting of Virginia's eastern shore. Wallace has dozens of blinds ready for your party and you can target puddle ducks, diving ducks and geese. After the hunt, it's time to enjoy the equally famous Chincoteague oysters!

If you'd like to try Chesapeake Bay fishing this year contact W2 Charter Captains like Kevin Salmon of Chesapeake Unlimited Sportfishing or Clint Gray (see Smith Mountain Lake section) who switches over to Bay rockfishing in the winter.

It's that time of year when it's cold outside and the hunting season is winding down. The hunters will be putting their hunting gear away and thinking about fishing and the fair weather anglers will be waiting for a nice warm sunny day to go fishing. The die-hard anglers will still be fishing.

January is the month you can catch your biggest bass of the new year. If you are planning to go fishing, start by checking the weather report before you go and dress accordingly.

Even though our water levels reached historical lows this fall, there are still nice fish to be caught and water levels have risen after December rainfall.

River water temperatures are in the low forties to high thirties and the fish are lethargic. Remember that fish are cold blooded creatures, so the water temperature is the same as their body temperature. Their metabolism slows dramatically, and their energy levels are greatly reduced, which means they eat less often and suspend most of the time, however they are opportunistic feeders.

This time of year, the water temperatures have acclimated as well as the fronts. Go to the deepest pools that you can find. If you can find water deeper than 8 to 10 feet, it is more likely there will be fish close to or laying with their belly slightly touching the bottom. They will move around occasionally but will gravitate to steep banks where they can move up and down in the water column.



This helps them expend less energy, but make no mistake when the opportunity presents itself and if the offering looks appealing, they will eat.

When you plan your outing look for warming trends up to a weeklong and take advantage of them. Winter always throws a curveball, but just like hunting, some of the nastiest weather makes hunting

Punisher hair jigs work extremely well, and Jenkins jigs are also a great option. Whatever your preference is stick with natural colors.

Make sure you use trailers that have little to no movement or action. Anglers must remember the water is extremely cold and all baitfish and other creatures' movement are slow. Another overlooked option that does not get much attention in the rivers are the black marabou iigs. These jigs in 1/16 to

good. The same applies to fishing; some of the biggest fish have been caught in the worse weather.

If you have some wind, take advantage of it and fish the windy banks if possible. In fishing they always say that the, "The wind is your friend", but there is also a time where there is just too much wind and then you must look for the sheltered banks.

When you find a deeper pool start out with faster moving baits like flat sided crankbaits, bladed baits, jerkbaits hard and soft as well as lipless crankbaits. On these types of baits your color selections can be browns, greens, for cravfish patterns as well as baitfish colors such as reflective iridescent colors of blues purple and silvers.

If you are not getting any takes with faster moving baits, then you need to slow your presentation down. This is the time of year that hair jigs will shine. There are several companies that make hair jigs and there are many different versions.

1/8 ounce are killers in cold water when slowly moved along the bottom of the river with the current. I believe that these jigs imitate the madtoms of the Shenandoah, and these tiny morsels are like candy for smallmouth and largemouth bass. If you can find them with a weed guard it is even better.

There are many options other than hair jigs such as Ned heads which are preferred by a lot of anglers because they work well. With Ned rigs you have lots of options for trailers such as Zman TRD's , Berkley Maxscent Lil' Super Trooper craws and the Yamamoto Ned Senko, which floats like the Zman products. Choose a bait that you are confident in because a bait that you have confidence in will be fished more precisely than one you have no confidence in.

There are lots of techniques out there that will work drop shotting, hover rigs, Damiki rigs, swimbaits and wacky rigs. Whatever you choose, go out and have fun and make some memories. I look forward to seeing you on the water. Lonnie Conner


